Supported Keyboards

- GageWay PRO interfaces can be set to support different keyboard layouts. This feature is only available when using the USB keyboard wedge output port to transfer data
 - USA / Canada (default)
 - Mexico / Latin America
 - UK / Australia
 - French
 - Belgium
 - German





Set Keyboard Layout

- Plug the USB cable into the GageWay Pro USB "Serial" port and the computer
- Open the GageWay Pro Setup program and click on the "Find & Read the GageWay Pro Setup" button







View Supported Keyboards

- To view the supported keyboard layouts
 - Click on the ComTestSerial test program icon in the GageWay
 Pro Setup program
 - Type <\$CK in the upper window, the supported keyboard layouts will be displayed automatically
 - Upper case (CK) only
 - See next slide for results

Change Layout

- Example: use Spanish (Mexico / Latin America) layout
 - In the ComTestSerial program, type <\$KM in the upper window
 - Upper case (KM) only
 - New layout is acknowledged just below the <\$KM command
 - See next slide for results





To Use New Layout

- Close GageWay Pro Setup & ComTestSerial programs
- Move the USB cable to the "Keyboard Wedge" port see RED box below
- All output will now use the selected keyboard layout
